## Navigating the Arizona BioMap

The Arizona BioMap, a statewide effort aligned with Arizona's Bioscience Roadmap, displays Arizona bioscience firms, research institutes, educational institutions, hospitals, and collaborating organizations.

**Clicking on a marker** on the BioMap will bring up contact information and a description of the firm/organization selected. Firms and organizations' names are hyperlinked to their Web sites, where available.

**The legend** in the upper-right corner of the BioMap identifies categories for the type of work done by firms and organizations on the map. To view on the map all firms and organizations in a particular category, click on its label in the legend. Click on "Show All" to return to a view of the full BioMap.

**To zoom** directly to a northern-, central-, or southern-Arizona regional view of the BioMap, click on one of the hyperlinks adjacent to the map, or follow one of these links, which will redirect to the appropriate regional view:

**Tabs** offering three text-based lists of the firms/organizations on the BioMap—alphabetical, categorical, geographic—are also adjacent to the map. Clicking on "view locations on separate page" presents all contact and descriptive information about the firms/organizations, in the order specified by the selected tab.
